In New Zealand, many medicines are available without a prescription, but that doesn't mean you should guess which one is right for you. Your pharmacist can help answer questions like:

- ✓ Can I take this with my other medications?
- ✓ What are the side effects?
- ✓ What happens if I miss a dose?
- ✓ Is there a funded alternative under Pharmac?

Pharmacists know medicines inside and out and can give you personalised advice on how to take them safely and effectively. If something isn't working for you, they can often suggest a better option or speak to your doctor on your behalf.

Minor Illness or Something More Serious?

New Zealand pharmacists are trained to assess common health concerns and let you know if you need to see a GP or if they can help you right away.

They can assist with:

 Colds, flu and coughs – Advice on symptom relief and recommend over the counter medicines

- ✓ Allergies and hay fever The best antihistamines or nasal sprays for your needs
- ✓ Skin conditions Eczema, acne, fungal infections and sunburn solutions
- ✓ Pain management Headaches, migraines, period pain and muscle pain relief
- ✓ Tummy troubles Reflux, nausea, diarrhoea and constipation relief

DID YOU KNOW ... Many pharmacies now offer consultations for minor ailments through funded pharmacy services, meaning you might not have to pay! If your symptoms suggest something more serious, your pharmacist will refer you to a doctor or even urgent care.

If you're managing a long-term condition like diabetes, high blood pressure, asthma, or arthritis, your pharmacist plays a key role in your healthcare team.

They can:

- \checkmark Help you understand your medications and how they work
- ✓ Suggest ways to manage side effects
- ✓ Offer in-store blood pressure checks
- ✓ Provide inhaler technique reviews to make sure you're getting the full benefit
- \checkmark Work with your GP to ensure your medicines are the best fit for you
